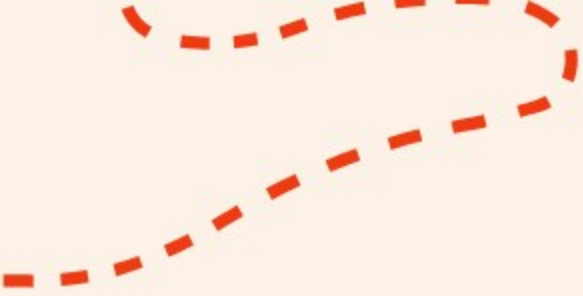

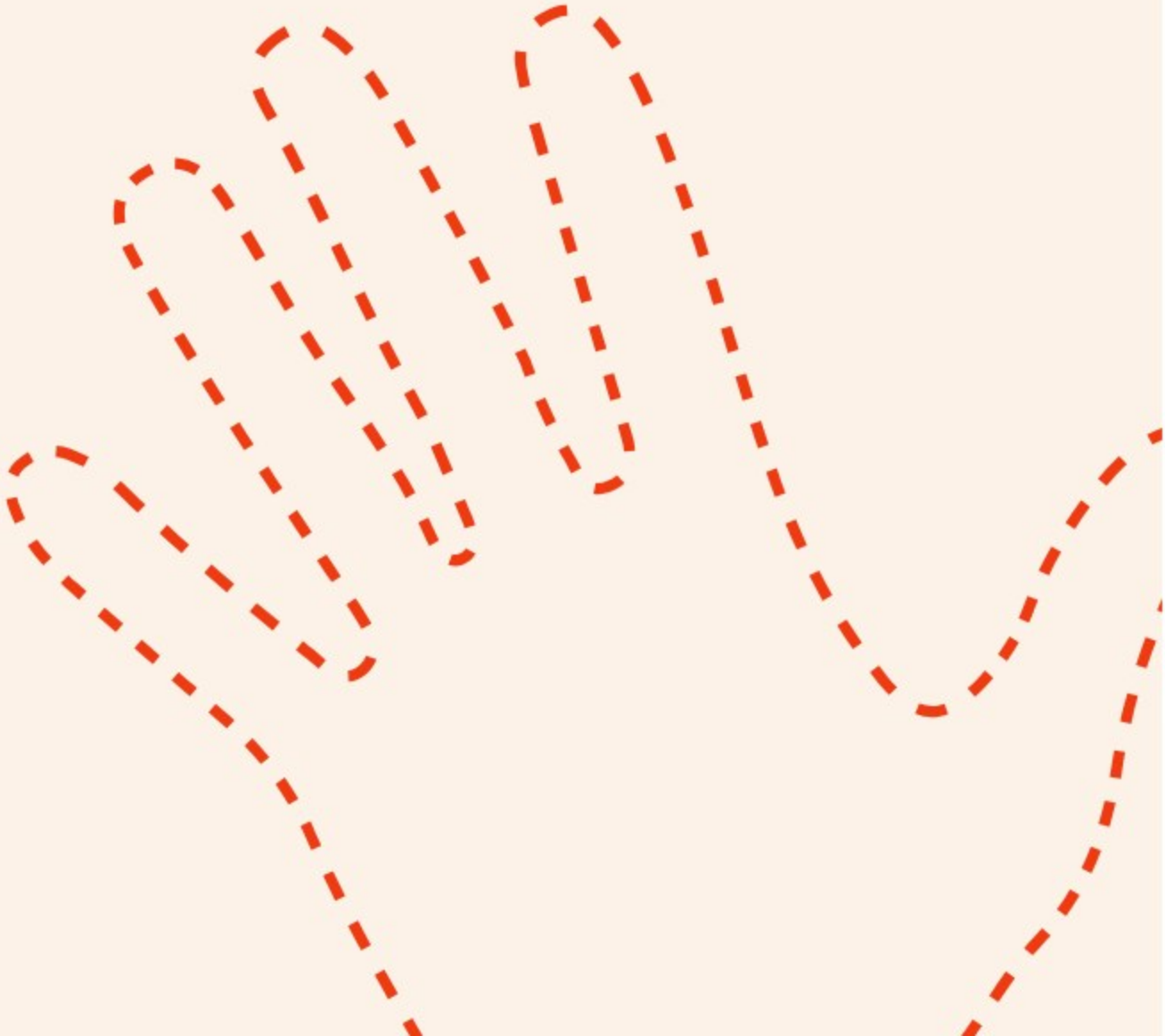

234 Commerce and Culture Expo

The 234 Commerce and Culture Expo was implemented to promote entrepreneurship, creativity, and cultural expression. The initiative supported business empowerment valued at ₦ 100,000,000.00 in Kaduna State.

It created a platform for showcasing commerce, innovation, and cultural heritage. The expo strengthened youth participation in the creative and business economy. It also fostered collaboration between students, creatives, and local stakeholders.

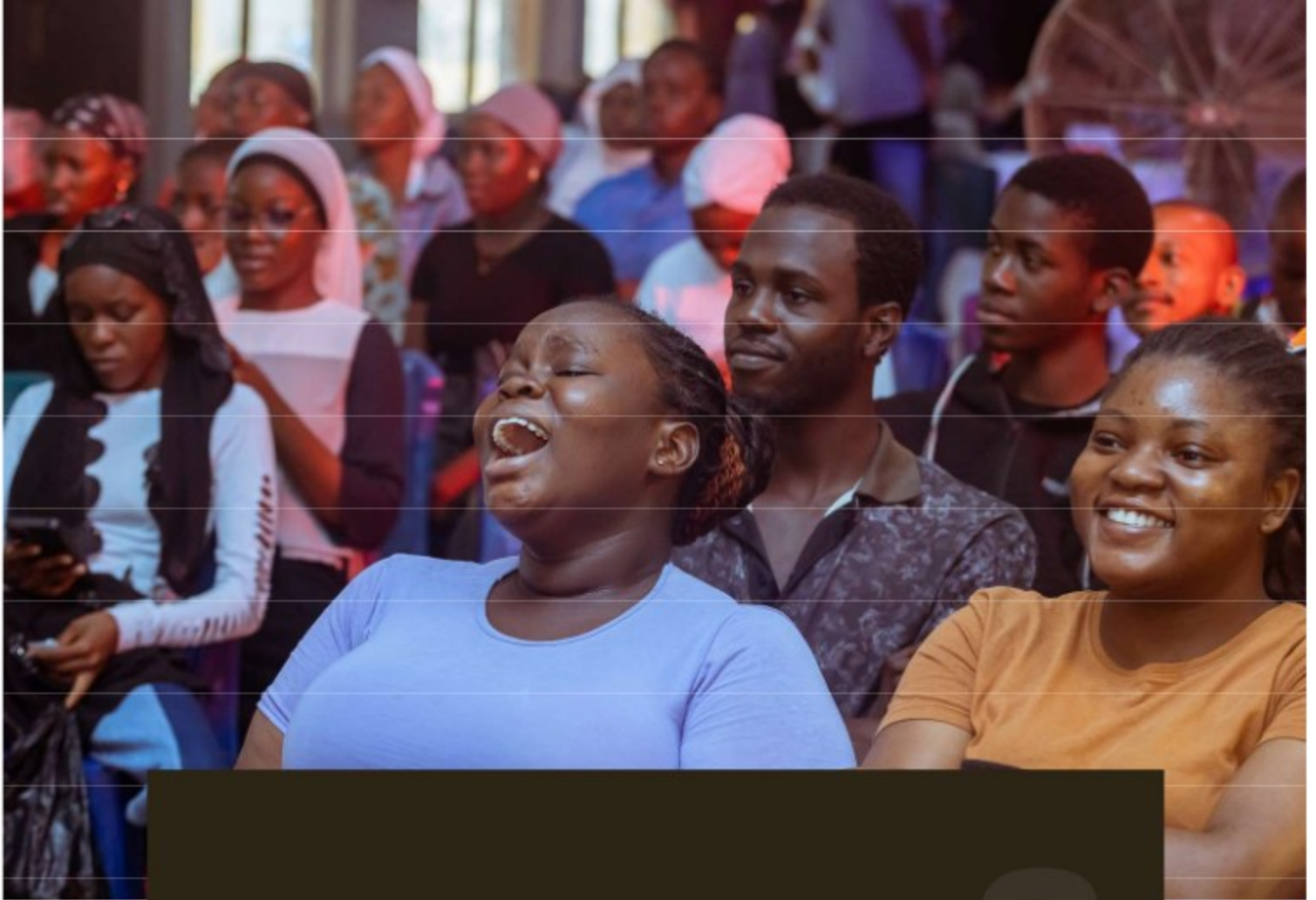


234 Data for Learning Challenge

This project aimed to enhance access to digital learning tools for young Nigerians. A total value of ₦500,000 worth of data was distributed to 300 young people. The initiative addressed digital exclusion and learning access

234 Impact Hubs

The 234 Impact Hubs initiative expanded structured learning access through institutional partnerships. The project reached 1,000 students across three institutions in Nigeria: Olabisi Onabanjo University, Ogun State, Ladoke

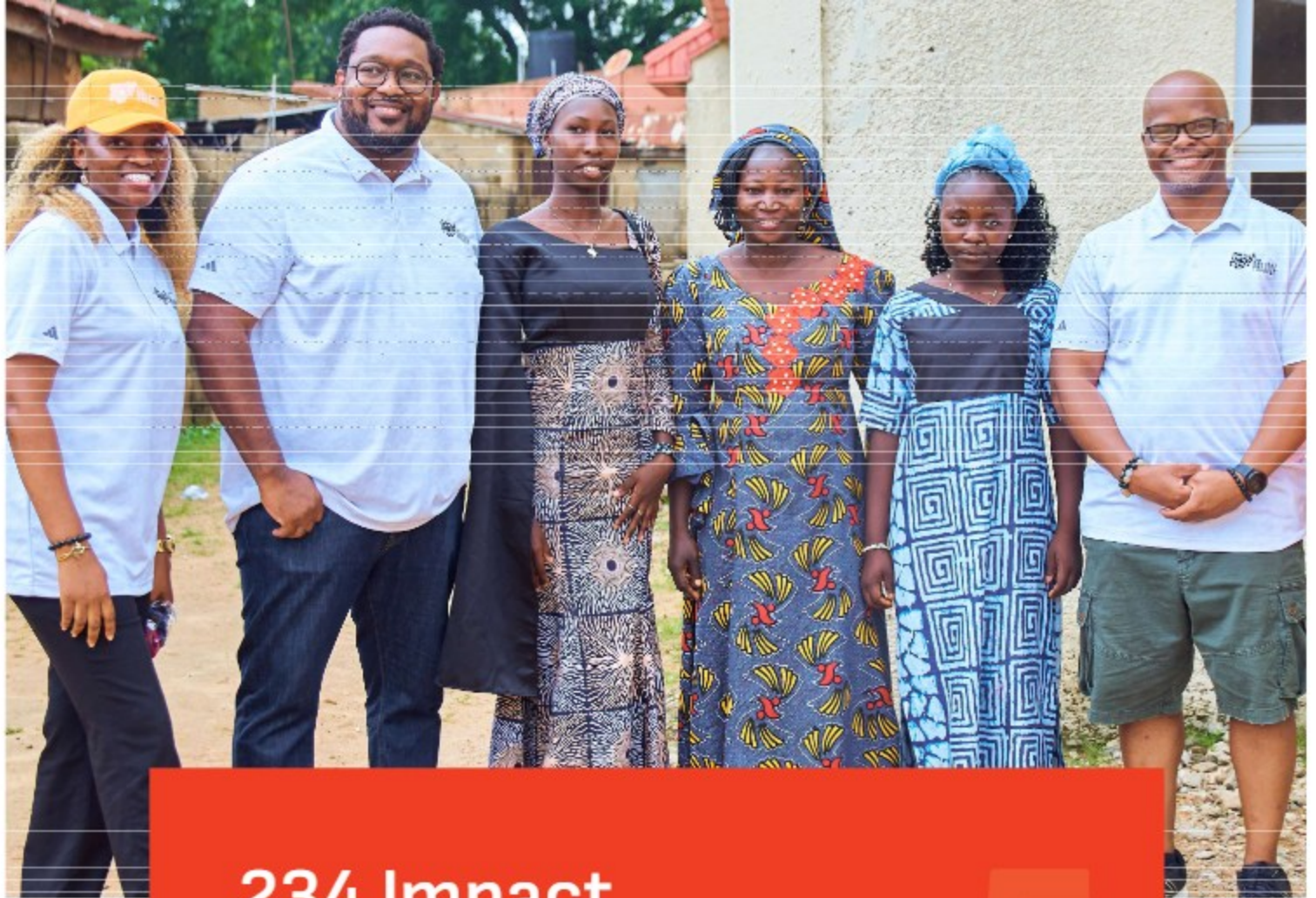

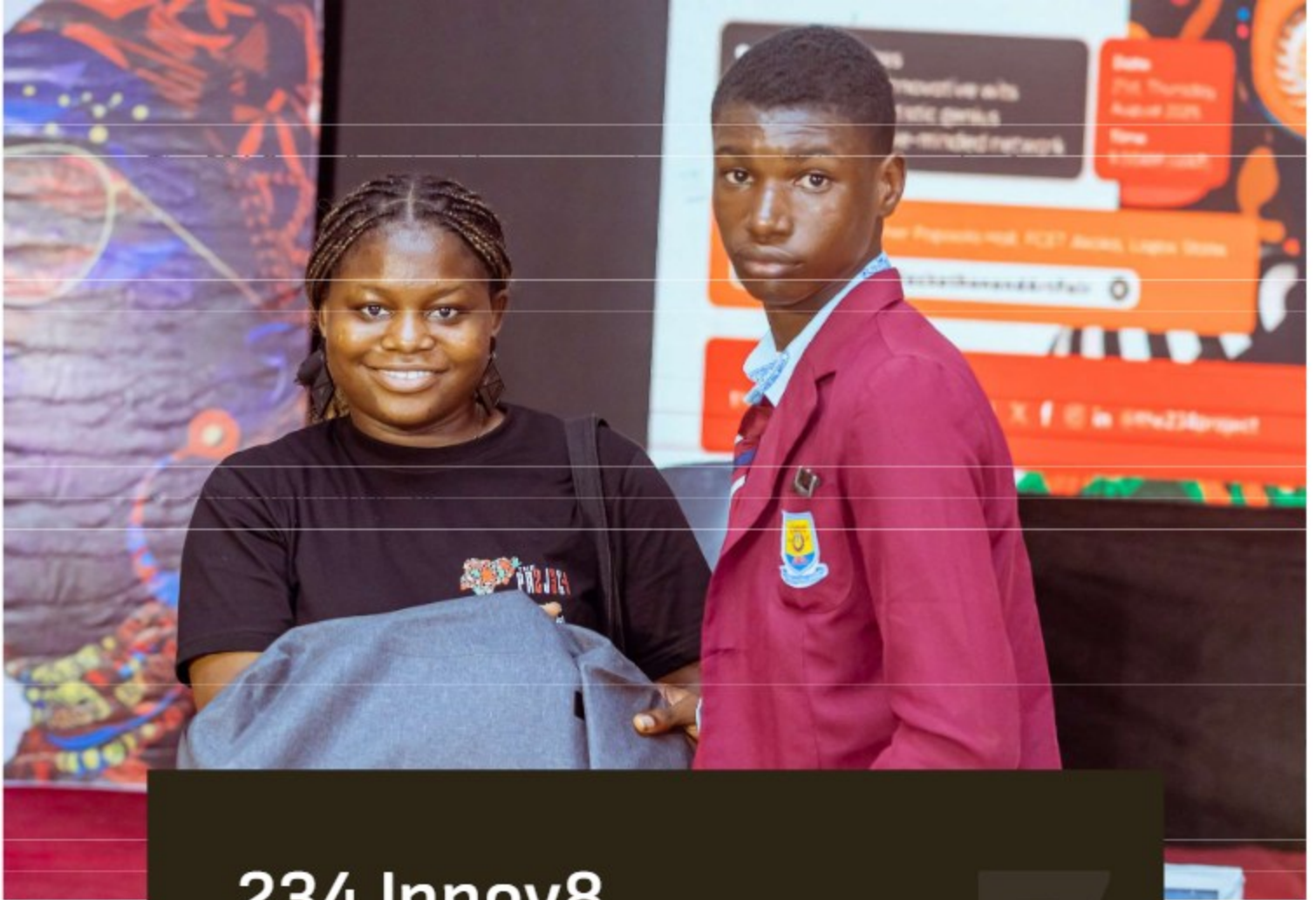
234 Community Impact Challenge (CIC) 4.0

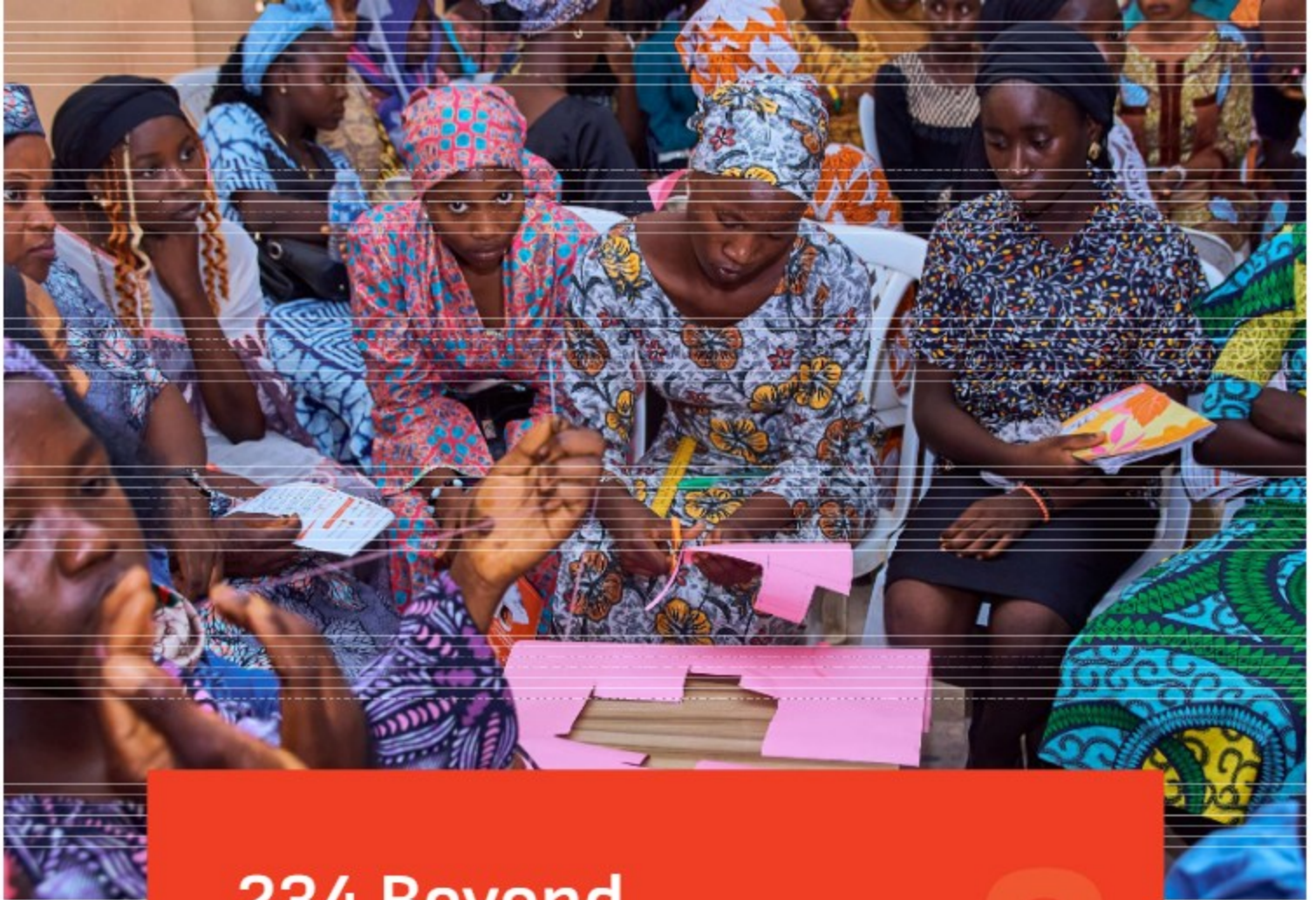
